We wish to inform parents and guardians that the School Department of Stoneham provides a Blanket Medical Accident Insurance policy for All High School Varsity and Sub-Varsity Teams.

It is understood, that in order not to place a financial burden on parents the student accident insurance policy will pay amounts in excess of those paid by personal medical/health insurance coverage only, and that your family insurance will be the first payee.

The intent of the school insurance policy is to provide adequate insurance coverage, prevent duplicate medical payments, and protect the parent from unnecessary medical bills.

NOTICE OF ATHLETIC INJURY RISK

Participation in all sports requires an acceptance of risk and possible injury. You as a player can help make the game safer by not intentionally using techniques which are illegal and which can cause serious injury. Participation in athletics is inherently dangerous. Even when all reasonable precautions are taken, students participate in athletics voluntarily with the permission of their parent(s)- Along with this participation, the students and their parent(s) or guardian(s) accept the inherent risks to which the students expose themselves.
